Speaker 2: Let's go. It's time to get on the field.

Lisa: It will be fun.

Billy: Playing soccer looks easy.

Speaker 2: All right, Lingokids team, it's game time. Welcome to story time by Lingokids where we discover fascinating facts about the world around us and the fun of play learning. Join us today and cheer us on as we play our first soccer game and learn about sportsmanship.

[whistle blows]

Referee blows the whistle ending the first half of the game. We'll take a quick break and be back for the second half. The score is 1-0. Soccer Rhinos with the lead.

Elliot: I was trying. Lisa didn't help me.

Lisa: I told you to pay attention.

Elliot: No, it's your fault.

Lisa: It was your fault. You didn't pay attention.

Elliot: Not true.

[whistle blows]

Speaker 2: Team, let's not fight. It's not fun and it's not good sportsmanship at all.

Lisa: What's a good sportsmanship?

[music]

Speaker 2: Sportsmanship, it's when you behave nicely when playing a sport and respect others. Even players on the other team. Arguing doesn't help us work as a team or help us try to win. Even worse, we won't have fun.

Elliot: I guess that's true.

Lisa: I'm sorry I said those things, Elliot.

Elliot: Me too.

Billy: Me three. [whistles]

Speaker 2: Do you think we're ready to go back out there?

Lingokids: Yes.

Speaker 2: Okay, everyone. Let's say Lingokids on the count of three. One, two,

three.

Lingokids: Lingokids.

[whistle blows]

Speaker 1: The second half begins and the Soccer Rhinos have the ball. Their forward, Huan, takes it towards the goal again and shoots. Oh, what a great block by Lisa on the Lingokids team.
